



#### **BEETHOVEN**

The Beethoven Violin Concerto premiered in 1806 to less than glowing reviews. Perhaps the technical demands inhibited a successful presentation. 38 years later a 12 year old Joseph Joachim performed it, with Felix Mendelssohn conducting the London Philharmonic, to rave reviews. Ever since, the work has become one of the most performed and beloved concertos in the repertoire. Although the form and harmonic structure are classical, Beethoven's Violin Concerto trail-blazed with length and depth, as well as offering the soloist a vehicle for their musical rather than exclusively technical skills.



The Symphony No. 3 "Eroica" is widely considered the first Romantic Symphony, again trail-blazing with the length, breadth, harmonic and contextual content. The Symphony premiered in 1805. The dedication to Napoleon was rescinded purportedly because Bonaparte did not adherer to his early democratic inclinations, but perhaps also because the patronage paying the composer's fee may not have approved.

Later, about the composer's response to Napoleon having proclaimed himself Emperor of the French (14 May 1804), Beethoven's secretary, Ferdinand Ries said that:

In writing this symphony, Beethoven had been thinking of Bonaparte, but Bonaparte while he was First Consul. At that time Beethoven had the highest esteem for him, and compared him to the greatest consuls of Ancient Rome. Not only I, but many of Beethoven's closer friends, saw this symphony on his table, beautifully copied in manuscript, with the word "Bonaparte" inscribed at the very top of the title-page and "Ludwig van Beethoven" at the very bottom... I was the first to tell him the news that Bonaparte had declared himself Emperor, whereupon he broke into a rage and exclaimed, "So he is no more than a common mortal! Now, too, he will tread under foot all the rights of Man, indulge only his ambition; now he will think himself superior to all men, become a tyrant!" Beethoven went to the table, seized the top of the title-page, tore it in half and threw it on the floor. The page had to be recopied, and it was only now that the symphony received the title Sinfonia eroica

Lilyanne Thoroughman is homeschooled student from Williamstown, Kentucky. At age 4 she announced that she would learn to play the violin just after a performance of the Cincinnati Symphony Orchestra in Music Hall. By age 5 she was playing and soon became a violin student of Kurt Sassmannshaus in 2011. In 2015, she joined the Starling Chamber Orchestra, where she has been a frequent soloist, performing in concerts, chamber recitals, and masterclasses.

In 2016, Lilyanne made her debut as an international soloist with the Starling Chamber Orchestra, playing Elgar's Salut d'Amour and the Vivaldi Concerto for Four

Violins in six concerts in southern China. She is a featured violinist on violinmasterclass.com. She was a soloist in 2016 with the Kentucky Symphony Orchestra playing Danse Macabre by Saint Saens, and with the Blue Ash Montgomery Symphony Orchestra playing the Mendelssohn Violin Concerto. Lilyanne appeared on From the Top in March of 2016. In the summer of 2019, Lilyanne was associate concertmaster at age twelve of the Blue Lake International Youth Orchestra, playing concerts in six cities in France and Germany.

Lilyanne has performed at the Innsbrook Music Festival and at the Bowdoin Music Festival in Brunswick, Maine. She has been a contributor to From the Top's "Daily Joy." Lilyanne enjoyed participating from home in the Starling Project's online summer program. She performed the Shostakovich Violin Concerto in masterclasses for Augustine Haedlich and for Victor Tretyakov and Natalia Likhopoi.

#### BEAUFORT SYMPHONY YOUTH ORCHESTRA

#### Mission:

The Beaufort Symphony Youth Orchestra (BSYO) mission, through its involvement with the Beaufort Symphony Orchestra, is to demonstrate musical career options to our students. The students learn that a community orchestra can be a part of their future wherever they live. We are taking a two-prong approach:

- 1. The Beaufort Symphony Orchestra invites young new talent as guest solo artists each year. We encourage our students to attend rehearsals, spend time with the guest artists, get to know them and learn how they achieved their current skill level.
- 2. Fred invites our students with advanced skills to join the Beaufort Symphony Orchestra to experience how a Community Orchestra operates and what a professional orchestra requires of its participants. This gives the students an opportunity to play with professionals, improve their skills and learn how a community orchestra experience could be in their future.

#### Motto:

Our motto is encouragement. We invite all students to participate whether they are home schooled or students in our private and/or public institutions. We do require our students to audition. Auditioning provides experience, promotes professionalism and gives each student an opportunity for advancement year after year. Particularly with our string section, the auditions provide for some friendly competition on who has made the most improvement over the summer.

To encourage growth in the skills of our students, we offer various forms of scholarships. Private lessons (with practice time) have the most significant impact on our students. They learn to work hard, to be accountable for their lessons and, through that, they develop a deeper love of music and/or their instrument. Private lessons are particularly important for our younger students to help them adjust quickly to the Orchestra environment. For our more advanced students, private lessons help them take their skills to a level enabling them to participate in prestigious music camps, such as Brevard, attend the Governor's School and/or study music in college.

#### **Contribute:**

There are many ways to contribute to our student's growth in the program.

- 1. Student scholarships cover BSYO dues so that EVERY child who wants to join our Youth Orchestra can. Annual dues are \$175/per student.
- 2. Lesson scholarships cover 50% of the cost of a weekly private lesson. Annual scholarships are available for \$1200/student. Monthly scholarships are available for \$200/month/student.

- 3. Instruments. Some students cannot afford their own instrument so they have to borrow one from school. However, most of the time, that means the student will not take it home to practice. Therefore, if you have a used instrument that you no longer use, consider donating it outright or lending it to the BSYO for use by a budding musician.
- 4. Summer camp scholarships cover summer music camp costs for BSYO students. Our younger students will be able to attend beginner Orchestra camps that are typically a week long. Our older students will be able to audition to attend more advanced music programs such as the Brevard Music Center or Meadowmount School of Music, which are typically about 6-weeks long.

#### **Growing the Orchestra:**

For many years now, Ami Rabinowitz has developed a feeder program. This successful program has grown into a small cadet orchestra and year-round mentoring for a quartet. Anyone interested in joining an ensemble or having private lessons should call Ami at 843-263-6439 for information.

#### Giving back to the Community:

Our students share their gifts through performances and events in our community. The BSYO performs three concerts annually. It performs each concert in two venues for a total of six performances in Beaufort County. We have between 15-30 students participating in our program this year. If you have not been to a BSYO concert yet, consider attending one this season!






