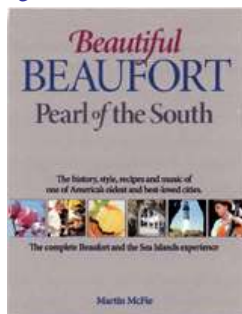
### 2014-2015 Schedule –Beaufort Symphony Orchestra

## Announcing BSYO Scholarships



The BSO Board will award \$25,000 in Summer Music

Camp scholarships via the Judith Haskell Brewer Grant. The anonymous donor increased the grant this year by \$3,000 to recognize and reward exemplary music students. It is the third year we have received this wonderful grant.

Seventeen BSYO members will receive camp scholarships to include Brevard Music Center, Furman Univ., Peabody Music Conservatory, UNCG, UNC School of Arts, USC Music Conservatory, Charleston Southern, and Florida State Univ.

Tiegue Brougham-Cook, bass, will attend the prestigious Brevard Music Center camp where Itzak Perlman will perform the opening concert. Bassoonist Bryce Richardson, a 10<sup>th</sup> grader, has been accepted into the SC Governor’s School for the Arts and Humanities as well as the Peabody Bassoon Camp. Allison Crandall, 11<sup>th</sup> grade trumpet player, will attend the USC Music Conservatory. And seven BSYO members who play in quartets coached by Ami Rabinowitz will attend a three week Chamber music camp.
