2013-2014 BSO Season Opens with "The Last Word" of Haydn & Dvorak October 10th & 13th

Franz Joseph Haydn and Antonin Dvorak give us their "Last Word" in the Beaufort Symphony Orchestra's first concert of the 2013-2014 Season.

Haydn's Symphony No. 104, popularly known as "The London Symphony," was composed in Vienna in 1795 following a stay in London during which he composed the first six of the 12 "London" series.

Dvorak's Symphony No.9, known as "The New World Symphony" was composed in 1893 while he was living in America.

Written some 100 years apart, their last symphonies are among the most celebrated by musicians and music lovers alike


