“Symphonic Showcase” opens BSO 30th Anniversary Concert Season

The Beaufort Symphony Orchestra's first concert on October 22nd and 25th features two of the greatest composers of all time, Joseph Haydn and Ludwig van Beethoven, in a “Symphonic Showcase” to usher in its 2015-2016 season, beginning our 30th anniversary celebration.

The second of Haydn's 12 London Symphonies, Symphony No. 94 in G Major was written in 1791. Known as the “Surprise Symphony” due to a sudden, loud chord amidst a gentle staccato in the second movement, the work is typical of his subtle wit. Despite the fame of the work based on this musical joke, the rest of the piece is a brilliant, virtuoso tour de force, filled with charm, drama and warmth.

Beethoven fondly referred to his Symphony No. 8 in F, written in 1812, as “my Little Symphony in F” in contrast to the much longer “Pastoral” Symphony No. 6. The work is also filled with little jokes and imitations and is described as the most delightful and humorous of his works. Unusually upbeat for Beethoven, it reveals the influence of his friend and mentor, Joseph Haydn.

Concerts are funded in part by the SC Arts Commission which receives support from the National Endowment for the Arts.




