Our Conductor, Maestro Frederick Devyatkin, directs an ensemble of over 55 professional musicians whose repertoire ranges from Hollywood and Broadway tunes to classical masterpieces. In addition to conducting the Beaufort Symphony Orchestra, Maestro Devyatkin leads our Youth Orchestra program that attracts students from around the region (Beaufort, Bluffton, Hilton Head, and Savannah).
